DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER FOR PUBLIC HEALTH EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, a novel coronavirus, now designated SARS-CoV2 which causes the disease COVID-19, has spread through the world and has now been declared a global pandemic by the World Health Organization; and

WHEREAS, extraordinary measures must be taken to contain COVID-19 and prevent its spread throughout Westover Hills and Tarrant County, Texas.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE TOWN OF WESTOVER HILLS, TEXAS:

- 1. That a local state of disaster for public health emergency is hereby declared for Town of Westover Hills, Texas, pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. Pursuant to section 418.108(b) of the Government Code, the state of disaster for public health emergency shall continue until such time that it is rescinded by the Town Council.
- 3. Pursuant to section 418.108(c) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster for public health emergency shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the Town Secretary.
- 4. Pursuant to section 418.108(d) of the Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster activates the Town's Emergency Management Plan.
- 5. That this proclamation shall take effect immediately from and after its issuance.
